Article 1 - Organisation

<u>Article 11 - Information technology and civil liberties</u>

<u>Article 12: Personal data</u>

1978, and EU regulation n°2016/679 of 27 April 2016). In this context, personal data may be transmitted and/or stored in countries outside the European Union. <u>Article 13: Applicable law - competent courts</u>

Article 14: RGPD processing

These rules provide for the processing of personal data with regard to Regulation EU (2016/679) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC and the Law of 1 August 2019 on the organisation of the National Data Protection Commission and the general data protection regime.

Thus, the processing of the personal data of any natural person who may be directly involved in setting up the game or, indirectly, by participating in the performance of the obligations arising from this operation shall be carried out in accordance with the terms of this clause.
